



DIPLOMA IN COMPUTER APPLICATION, BUSINESS ACCOUNTING & MULTILINGUAL DTP (CABA-MDTP) 'O' LEVEL.

Since July 2010, SVS has been organizing the "Diploma in Computer Application, Business Accounting & Multilingual DTP" (CABA-MDTP) 'O' Level course. This program is a collaborative effort between the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL) under the Ministry of Human Resource Development and the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), Chandigarh under the Ministry of Communication & Information Technology.

The main objective of this course is to transform the Urdu-speaking population into a technologically proficient and employable workforce. By providing comprehensive training in computer applications, business accounting, and multilingual desktop publishing, the course aims to enhance job opportunities and increase computer literacy among Urdu speakers.



- Skill Development in Key Areas: The CABA-MDTP 'O' Level course covers essential areas such as computer applications, business accounting, and multilingual desktop publishing. This comprehensive curriculum ensures that participants gain a broad set of skills relevant to the modern job market.
- Focus on Urdu-Speaking Population: By targeting the Urdu-speaking community, the program helps bridge the digital divide and promotes inclusivity in the technological workforce.
- Collaborative Effort: The joint effort of NCPUL and NIELIT ensures that the course meets high standards of education and relevance, benefiting from the expertise and resources of both organizations.

The Special School for Persons with Disabilities, located at Patel Nagar, Gaya Road, Islampur in Nalanda district, is dedicated to supporting individuals with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intelactual Disabilities, and Multiple Disabilities. This initiative is supported by The National Trust under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi.

The VIKAAS Scheme, also known as "RAHBAR," operates as a day care center where 31 persons with disabilities (PwDs) receive comprehensive support. The school provides a wide range of facilities including educational, vocational training, and medical services to ensure the holistic development of PwDs.

Additionally, the school aims to support family members by offering respite care, allowing them to manage other responsibilities during the day.

- Enhancing medical facilities to provide even better care for PwDs.

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

ADIP SCHEME (ASSISTANCE TO DISABLED PERSONS FOR PURCHASE/FITTING OF AIDS AND APPLIANCES)

With the support of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, an assessment camp was organized on March 3, 2024, in Islampur, Nalanda (Bihar) 801303. During this camp, we identified 95 persons with disabilities (PwDs) who required aids and appliances. Positive feedback was received from beneficiaries, indicating significant improvements in their daily lives and social integration.





Following the assessment camp, the procurement process for the required aids and appliances was undertaken. All items procured adhered to the required quality standards and specifications to ensure they meet the beneficiaries' needs.

Types of Aids and Appliances Procured:

- Mobility aids (e.g., crutches, wheelchairs, walking sticks)
- Hearing aids
- Visual aids (e.g., braille kits, low vision aids)
- Prosthetic and orthotic devices (e.g., artificial limbs, braces)

The successful implementation of the ADIP Scheme has had a profound impact on the lives of 95 individuals with disabilities. We extend our sincere gratitude to the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, for their financial support and guidance. Our organization remains dedicated to continuing our efforts to support and empower persons with disabilities.

ONE YEAR URDU DIPLOMA COURSE IN URDU LANGUAGE (NCPUL)

Since the academic year 2007-08, SVS has been organizing a One Year Urdu Diploma Course with the support of the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL) under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Government of India. This program is dedicated to the promotion, development, and propagation of the Urdu language.

By providing comprehensive educational resources and a structured curriculum, the program aims to enhance the proficiency of students in Urdu, thereby contributing to the preservation and growth of the language.

• Comprehensive Curriculum: The course offers an in-depth curriculum covering various aspects of the Urdu language, including grammar, literature, and composition.

 Resource Distribution: We distribute books and all relevant course materials to ensure that students have access to high-quality educational resources.

 Library Provision: A well-equipped library is available for students, providing additional resources to support their learning and research needs.

Qualified Instructors: The program is delivered by experienced and qualified instructors who
are proficient in Urdu, ensuring high-quality teaching and learning experiences.

Over the years, the One Year Urdu Diploma Course has achieved significant milestones, including:

• Increased Enrollment: A steady increase in the number of students enrolling in the course, reflecting growing interest and commitment to learning Urdu.

• Enhanced Language Proficiency: Improved language skills among participants, enabling them to read, write, and communicate effectively in Urdu.

 Cultural Preservation: Contributing to the preservation of the Urdu language and culture by educating new generations of speakers and writers.


Health Hygine & Sanitation Programme

This is an old proverb that "Health is wealth". To providing and promotion of health standard facility, there are three things obligatory. The Health intervention facility should be Accessible, Available & Affordable in time by the any section of community. SVS work is beyond its periphery. Our targeted and concerned focused activities are, to facilitate and promotion of standard of Health, Hygiene & Sanitation activities.

NIRAMAYA (Health Insurance Scheme)

SVS is running the NIRAMAYA Health Insurance Scheme, supported by The National Trust under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. This scheme aims to provide affordable health insurance to persons with disabilities (PwDs), including those with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intelactual Disability, and multiple disabilities. Currently, there are 232 enrolled/renewed PwDs under the NIRAMAYA scheme.

The main objective of the NIRAMAYA Health Insurance Scheme is to offer comprehensive health coverage to PwDs at an affordable rate, ensuring they have access to necessary medical services without financial burden.



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- Uniform Premium: The scheme has a single premium rate across all age bands, making it accessible and affordable for all eligible individuals.
- Universal Coverage: Provides the same coverage regardless of the type of disability covered under the National Trust Act.
- Insurance Coverage: Offers insurance coverage up to Rs.1.0 lakh on a reimbursement basis.
- Eligibility: All persons with disabilities covered under the National Trust Act, holding a valid disability certificate, are eligible for the scheme.
- Comprehensive Services: The scheme covers a wide range of services including:
 - Regular medical checkups
 - Hospitalization
 - Therapy sessions
 - Corrective surgeries
 - Transportation for medical treatments
- No Pre-Insurance Medical Tests: Beneficiaries are not required to undergo pre-insurance medical tests to qualify for coverage.
- Flexible Treatment Options: Treatment can be availed from any hospital, providing flexibility and convenience to the beneficiaries.

The NIRAMAYA scheme has significantly impacted the lives of PwDs by providing essential health coverage. Key achievements include:

- Increased Access to Healthcare: Enabled 232 PwDs to access necessary medical services without financial strain.
- Improved Health Outcomes: Regular checkups and timely medical interventions have improved the overall health and well-being of beneficiaries.
- Financial Relief: Reduced the financial burden on families of PwDs by covering medical expenses up to Rs.1.0 lakh.

The NIRAMAYA Health Insurance Scheme is a crucial initiative supported by The National Trust, aimed at providing comprehensive and affordable health coverage to persons with disabilities. Through this scheme, SVS is committed to improving the health and well-being of PwDs, ensuring they receive the medical care they need without financial hardship. Our ongoing efforts focus on expanding and enhancing the scheme to better serve the community and promote the inclusion and health security of all eligible PwDs.

HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE PROGRAMME

On the occasion of World Population Day, 11th July 2023, SVS organized a one-day workshop titled "Population and its Remedial Measures." The workshop aimed to address the pressing issues related to population growth and to discuss effective remedial measures.

The workshop saw active participation from various stakeholders, including: Doctors, Auxiliary Midwives (ANMs), Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHAs), Students, Parents, Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs), Local officials, others.



World Disability Day Celebration (Rally)


